<p>KIDS Draw a picture of your family doing your favourite Christmas activity</p>	<p>PARENTS Watch your child's favourite TV show and ask them what they love about it</p>	<p>FAMILY Bake Christmas biscuits for your neighbour and attach a Christmas card</p>
<p>KIDS Offer to do a chore that's not normally yours</p>	<p>PARENTS Bring out photos of your children and share a special story about that memory</p>	<p>FAMILY Offer to do a chore for your neighbour (mow their lawn, take their trash out, wash their windows)</p>
<p>KIDS Ask your parent how their day was and listen to the answer</p>	<p>PARENTS Read the Christmas Story with your kids before bed (consider using a nativity to help them visualize and play)</p>	<p>FAMILY Invite your neighbours to a Christmas service at your church, a play at your school or another Christmas activity</p>
<p>KIDS Think of something nice you want someone to do for you, and do the same for your parent</p>	<p>PARENTS Make your child's favourite meal or pudding</p>	<p>FAMILY Have your kids draw a manger scene and let them share the Christmas story with a neighbour</p>
