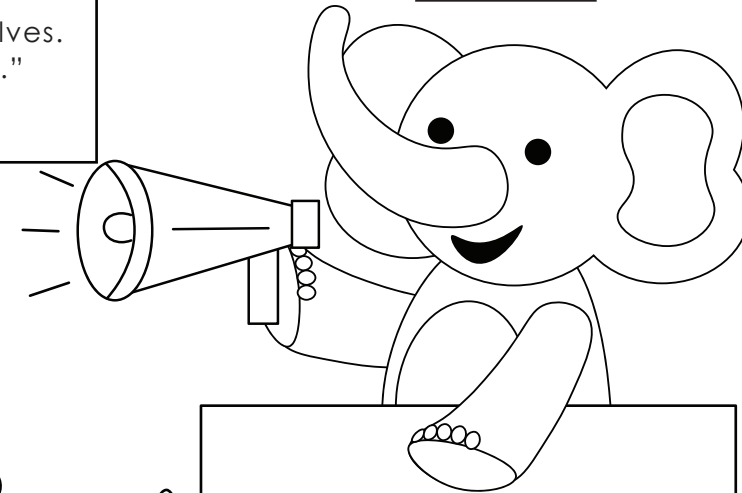
WHAT THIS PUBLIC HOLIDAY IS ABOUT:

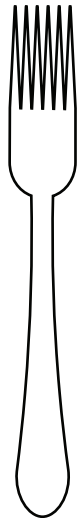
WHAT THE BIBLE SAYS ABOUT IT
