WHAT THE BIBLE SAYS ABOUT IT

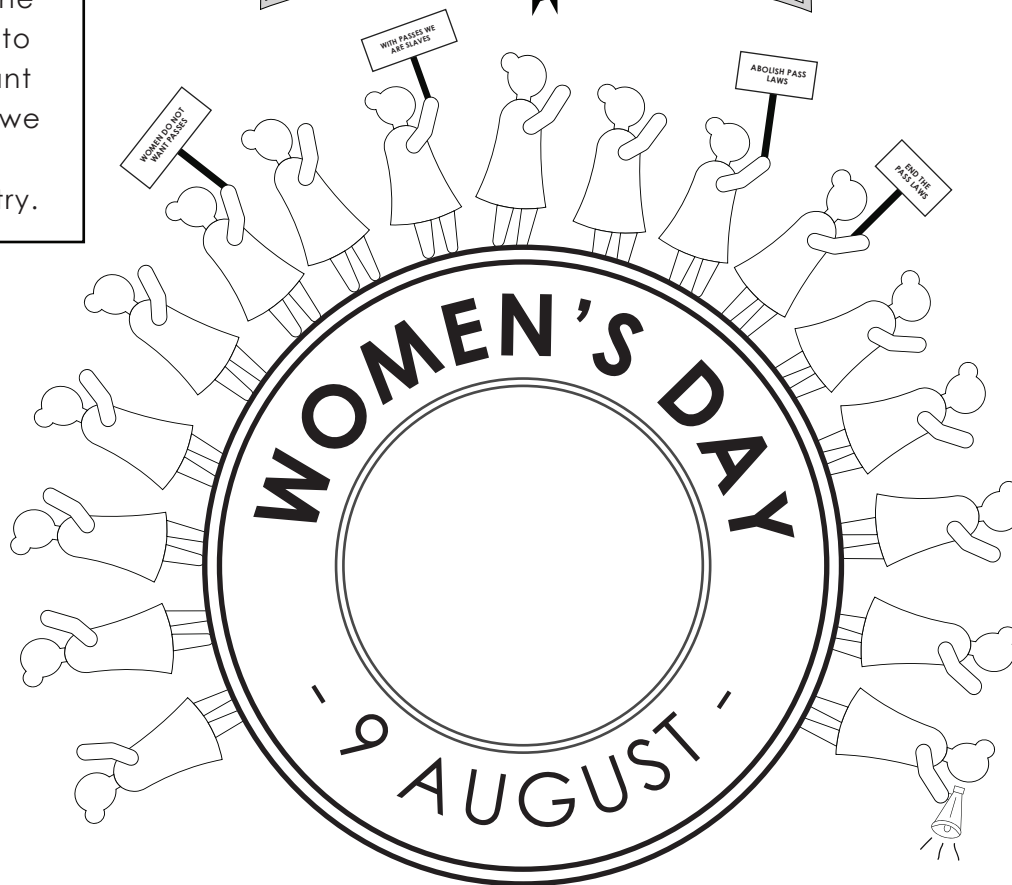
"There is no longer Jew or Gentile, slave or free, male and female. For you are all one in Christ Jesus."
